

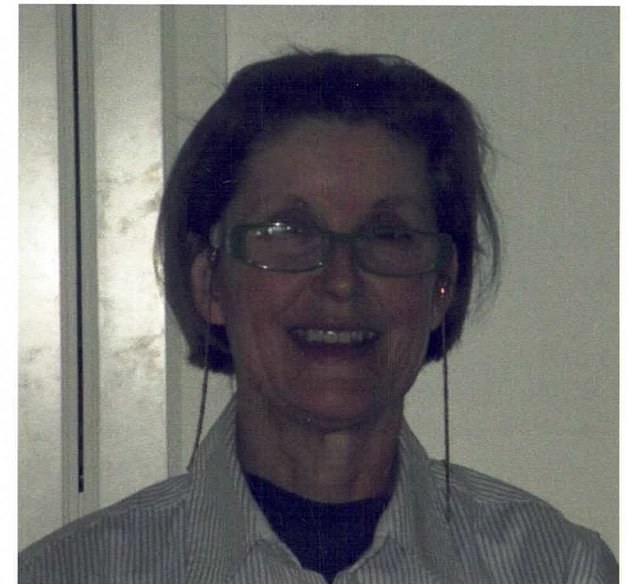

The upgrade and maintenance of parks, reserves, tennis courts, swimming pools and playgrounds assists community amenity and cultural status.
